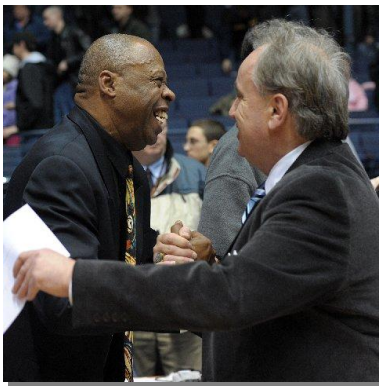

Despite Damone Brown's team-high 22 points and Cameron Stanley's 19 tallies, the Stampede were corralled 114-89. Corey Herring and Andy Robinson each added 17 points for Buffalo. Brown's 9 rebounds were tops for the Stampede.</p> <p>With new players in the lineup, the Stampede returned to the Koessler Athletic Center to face the Manchester Millrats. Both teams kept it close all night, and with 15 seconds to go, Manchester had the ball and was pressing down the court. Suddenly, the Stampede's Markus Price stole the ball, passed it to Andy Robinson, who drained a three-point shot with the clock barely ticking down to zero. Buffalo wins their second game of the season, a 114-111 triumph over Manchester. Markus Price finished with 22 points, while Kevin Ross added 21 points and 13 boards. Newly-signed Damone Brown popped a double-double of 13 points and 14 team-high rebounds.</p>

Although Halifax held a slight 49-48 lead at halftime, the Capitanes pulled ahead and eventually took the win, 108-101. Jevohn Shepherd's 24 points were tops among all Rainmen; while Adris DeLeon added 20 for the Nova Scotia crew. Desmond Ferguson's 18 points included four 3-pointers.</p> <p>Then it was back to the MetroCentre to take on the two-time PBL champion Rochester Razorsharks. With Eric Crookshank back in the lineup, and his 21 points, 15 rebounds and five major blocked shots, the revitalized Rainmen ran roughshod over the Razorsharks, winning 102-99. Desmond Ferguson added five 3-pointers to augment his 26 team-leading points; Gary Ervin finished with 7 assists to go with his 12 points. With the win, Halifax ties Rochester for second place in the PBL standings.</p>

Nine of the ten players on the Cavs roster finished the game scoring in double figures, with Brandon Dean and the newly-signed Rashad Woods each having 21 points. Unfortunately for the GreenHawks, no matter what they did, the Sharks matched it and more, and at the end, Maryland left with a 138-113 road loss. Harvey Thomas had 20 points for the GreenHawks; Ray Cunningham led the team with 18 rebounds; Cunningham also scored 19 points. Byron Mouton and Scooter Sherrill had 13 points apiece.</p> <p>The Maryland GreenHawks' Saturday night home contest against the Vermont Frost Heaves was postponed due to blizzard conditions in the Rockville, Md. area. The game will be rescheduled at a later date.</p>

The Capitanes took advantage of a slow Buffalo start, and Angelo Reyes, Larry Ayuso and Andres Rodriguez put together 26 of Puerto Rico's first-quarter 33 points. At one point in the game, Puerto Rico held a 32-point lead over the Stampede, at which time Capitanes coach David Rosario let his bench players get some action. For the Capitanes, Angelo Reyes led the team in scoring with 21 points and 16 rebounds; while Jeffrion Aubry had 13 rebounds, 3 blocked shots and 11 points. Omar Alvarado scored 15 points, while Walter Hodge and David Cortes each put 12 points apiece on the scoreboard.</p> <p>The Capitanes next hosted the PBL's Canadian squads, with a Thursday night battle at Arecibo against the Halifax Rainmen. In one of the closest battles Puerto Rico has seen to date, the Capitanes came from behind to win 108-101 in the final minutes. Elias Ayuso and David Cortes each scored 23 points apiece in the game, while Jeffrion Aubry and Angelo Reyes each notched a double-double (Aubry with 18 points and 14 rebounds; Reyes with 14 points and 19 rebounds). Andres Rodriguez had a team-high 13 assists.</p> <p>The Quebec Keps, however, gave Puerto Rico one of their biggest scares of the season. On a warm Friday night in Arecibo, Puerto Rico and Quebec were knotted at 85-85 with only a scant few minutes left on the clock. But a last-second steal and a spectacular dunk by Jeffrion Aubry sealed the Capitanes' eighth win of the season, with a final score of 93-86. Haakim Johnson, the first pick in the 2010 PBL Entry Draft, came off the bench to lead Puerto Rico in scoring with 17 points. David Cortes followed with 16 points, while Angelo Reyes added a double-double of 14 points and 12 rebounds.</p>

With a 138-113 victory over the Hawks, the Sharks remain unbeaten on the season, with a perfect 5-0 record. Glen Dandridge scored 17 team-high points, one of nine Sharks to finish the game with a double-digit tally. Xavier Morton led all rebounders, pulling down 10 boards. Dandridge and Keith Friel (13 points) each had three 3-pointers apiece.</p> <p>Rochester's five-game unbeaten streak, however, came to a screeching halt Sunday afternoon at the Halifax MetroCentre. The Sharks' sharpest marksmen, Keith Friel and Jerice Crouch, were a combined 4-for-10 from 3-point range, and a late Sharks rally fell short as Halifax took a 102-99 win. Lincoln Smith's 18 points led all Sharks in scoring; while Crouch and Friel finished with 15 and 12 points, respectively. Glen Dandridge's 12 points included four steals. PBL MOURNS THE LOSS OF GREENHAWKS COACH OTIS HAILEY

The Premier Basketball League is saddened by news of the passing of Maryland GreenHawks head coach Otis Hailey. Hailey succumbed to kidney failure on the morning of January 30, 2010. He was 60 years old.

"On behalf of the Premier Basketball League, its players and staff, we send our condolences to Otis Hailey's family," said Dr. Severko Hrywnak, Chairman of the Board of the PBL.

Hailey had been named as coach of the Maryland GreenHawks on January 19, 2010, replacing then-head coach Rob Spon. Hailey coached two games for the GreenHawks, winning one against the Quebec Kebs and losing one game against the Rochester Razorsharks. His team was scheduled to host a home game against the Vermont Frost Heaves that Saturday.

GreenHawks forward Gordon Klaiber, on his Facebook page, paid tribute to his coach. "Live life to the fullest, especially when you understand your life. R.I.P Coach Otis."

Hailey has worked as a head coach for ten years, beginning in February 2001 when he was promoted from Assistant Coach to Head Coach of the International Basketball Association's Saskatchewan Hawks. He was also associated with minor league teams in Bakersfield, Tijuana, Calgary and Los Angeles, as well as in Jamestown (N.Y.) and in St. Catharines (Ont.).
